Days & Times: Monday to Friday each week 8.30 am to 3pm.

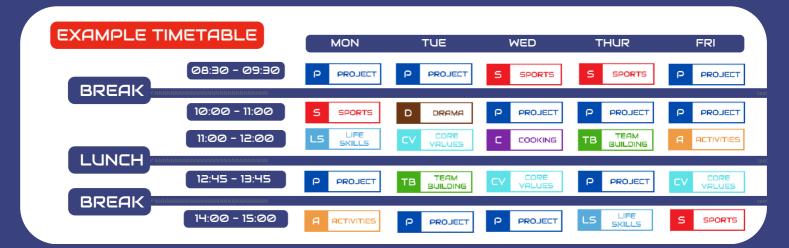
Age (5 to 15yrs): Power-up Academic English & Mindset is open to students from all schools (5 to 15 years old).

Life skills sessions are designed to help children to improve competencies and interpersonal skills. Sessions are designed to have practical understanding and outcomes for children that can be applied to their everyday life.



Inquiry-based projects are designed in-line with English lanuage learning connected to each weekly theme to guide students to investigate their interests related to the topics and guiding questions.



Core values sessions are designed around promoting personal beliefs, ideas and practices that influence how we best-conduct ourselves in our everyday lives. In these sessions we focus on being the best version of ourself!



Put down the iPad, mobile phones, switch off the TV and get active! With a focus on collaborative sports games and activities for children that help develop movement skills, confidence, and a love of being active.



Teambuilding focuses on boosting confidence and promoting self-esteem. Children are encouraged to learn the true value of collaboration in activities to achieve collective goals through synergy.

Drama sessions develop inter-personal skills and abilities such as speaking, critical thinking, self-confidence, time management, self-discipline and teamwork while exploring emotions, empathy and relationships.

Activity sessions are art & craft-based activities that link closely to each weekly theme. Using age-appropriate techniques and materials, children will engage in interesting activities designed to challenge their creative thinking.

Children learn about various baking styles and techniques where they are introduced to a variety of ingredients to fun and tasty cakes and biscuits. Cooking is a valuable life skill, and also something that children love to do at summer camp

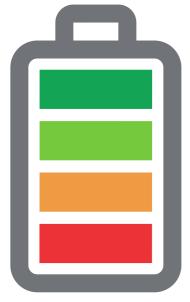
